## Training Committee Report

The end of August and into September are the busiest training times of the year. There have been to date since August 24th, IDNR Hunter Safety Class at Newark, Trap Fundamentals Class, IDNR Field Day Class, Conceal Carry Class 16 hr. and 3 hr. Renewal. This coming weekend several members will contribute to the Ronald McDonalds' House, fund raiser Shoot at Northbrook Sports Range in Hainesville, II. All these events to date have turned out to be very rewarding and span over 176 participants and counting.

Our club mission to promote gun safety, and shooting sports is working. The continued support of our members, the Park District, and Local Law Enforcement has been amazing.

I am happy to report that the IDNR has a new director who is trying to reopen closed park resources and address the poor state the IDNR has suffered from these past years. The Illinois State Conservation Police force just graduated a new group of CPOs' and has launched applications for more. (That alone is a miracle.) Add to that, our Governor has allocated 28.4 million to the effort. (Another miracle)

They have shared their efforts as instructors, apprenticeships for IDNR instructors, CPO's and just to sit in on the events. We have shared spirited stories, concerns, and hopes for the law enforcement community and it's future.

In our discussions I asked some questions you would not read about in the papers or see on the nightly news channels. I am happy to report that 100% of them fully support law abiding citizens on the subject of Conceal Carry, and In-Home Firearm Protection. The only preamble being "Law Abiding Citizens."

I think we can all share in the concerns for their efforts and safety in today's spirit we see for lack of support, restrictions on their ability to perform their jobs, and the bad press. 




