Firearm Safety Corner

The bill passed in the last 100th State Legislature to put more burden on gun dealers in this state was signed recently by the NOW Governor who presides under the 101st State Legislature. The ISRA has filed a lawsuit to get a Temporary Restraining Order under the grounds that the bill was left unsigned by the previous governor, held open and signed under the new Governor and State Legislature. To date less than half of the gun dealers in this state have started to enroll in the program. It is hoped that the TRO will lead to a full drop of the law and require the current legislature to start a new bill. There are several other bills in the soup right now or under forming committees to go after our rights. Keep calling your representatives and politely let them know your position on them. It makes a difference.

I saw a sign on I-55 recently that stated there are 4.6 million unsecured guns in this country right now. I am not sure of that figure and truly hope it is very wrong. Just one unsecured gun is too many. As Willie Robertson (Duck Dynasty) once said: "When the gun is not in my hand it is secured somewhere."

Finally, there is a campaign to open our State Constitution to provide reworking the state pension laws. Once this is open, they can and will restructure our rights and taxing laws. Under No Circumstances Can We Allow This to Happen. This fall, plan on voting this down on the ballot. The Governor has already pledged to raise taxes by 4.6 billion dollars in this state. Guess who pays for that?
